42. Licensing decisions often involve weighing a variety of competing considerations: the demand for licensed establishments, the economic benefit to the proprietor and to the locality by drawing in visitors and stimulating the demand, the effect on law and order,

the impact on the lives of those who live and work in the vicinity, and so on. Sometimes a licensing decision may involve narrower questions, such as whether noise, noxious smells or litter coming from premises amount to public nuisance. Although such questions are in a sense questions of fact, they are not questions of the “heads or tails” variety. **They involve an evaluation of what is to be regarded as reasonably acceptable in the particular location.** In any case, deciding what (if any) conditions should be attached to a licence as necessary and proportionate to the promotion of the statutory licensing objectives is essentially a **matter of judgement** rather than a matter of pure fact.

Sec 182 Guidance to the Licensing Act 2003

2. 1.5 However, the legislation also supports a number of other key aims and purposes. These are vitally important and should be principal aims for everyone involved in licensing work. They include:
 - **protecting the public and local residents from crime, anti-social behaviour and noise nuisance caused by irresponsible licensed premises;**
 - giving the police and licensing authorities the powers they need to effectively manage and police the night-time economy and **take action against those premises that are causing problems;**
 - recognising the important role which pubs and other licensed premises play in our local communities by minimising the regulatory burden on business, encouraging innovation and supporting responsible premises;
 - providing a regulatory framework for alcohol which reflects the needs of local communities and empowers local

authorities to make and enforce decisions about the most appropriate licensing strategies for their local area; and

- **encouraging greater community involvement in licensing decisions and giving local residents the opportunity to have their say regarding licensing decisions that may affect them.**

35. 8.37 If the beer garden or other outdoor area is to be used **for the consumption of off-sales only**, there is no requirement to show it on the plan of the premises, but the prescribed

application form requires the applicant to provide a description of where the place is and its proximity to the premises.

43. 8.46 While applicants are not required to seek the views of responsible authorities before formally submitting their application, they may find them to be a useful source of expert advice on local issues that should be taken into consideration when making an application. Licensing authorities may wish to encourage co-operation between applicants, responsible authorities and, **where relevant, local residents and businesses before applications are submitted in order to minimise the scope for disputes to arise.**

Epping Forest Policy

- 35.** 1.38 The Licensing Committee will expect individual applicants to address the licensing objectives in their Operating Plan, having regard to the type of premises, the licensable activities to be provided, the operational procedures, **the nature of the location and the needs of the local community.**
