**54. APPLICATION FOR A HACKNEY CARRIAGE DRIVER LICENCE**

The Sub-Committee considered an application for a Hackney Carriage Driver's Licence from Mr C Shakeel. The three councillors that presided over this item were Councillors P Keska (Chairman), L Mead and I Hadley.

The Sub Committee received a report on the application for Mr Shakeel. The Licensing Compliance Officer informed the Sub-Committee of the circumstances under which the licence could not be dealt with under delegated authority. Members of the Sub-Committee considered the report and the statement made at the hearing by the applicant.

The Chairman informed the applicant of the Sub-Committee's decision, and that the applicant had the right to appeal the decision in a Magistrate's Court within 21 days of the decision.

**Decision:**

1. That the application for a Hackney Carriage Driver's Licence by Mr C Shakeel be refused.
