The Licensee, that is the person in whose name the premises licence is issued, shall ensure that all times when the premises are for any licensable activity, there are sufficient competent staff on duty at the premises for the purpose of fulfilling the terms and conditions of the licence and for preventing crime and disorder. The Licensee shall ensure that all staff will undertake training in their responsibilities in relation to the sale of alcohol, particularly with regard to drunkenness and underage persons. Records will be kept of training and refresher training.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Any incidents of a criminal nature that may occur on the premises will be reported to the Police. The Licensee will install comprehensive CCTV coverage at the premises and it is operated and maintained at the premises. The CCTV system shall conform to the following points: 1. Cameras must be sited to observe the entrance and exit doors both inside and outside. Cameras on the entrances must capture full frame shots of the heads and shoulders of all people entering the premises i. e. capable of identification. 3. Cameras viewing till areas must capture frames not less than 50% of screen. 4. Cameras overlooking floor areas should be wide angled to give an overview of the premises. 5. Be capable of visually confirming the nature of the crime committed. 6. Provide a linked record of the date, time and place of any image. 7. Provide good quality images –colour during opening times. 8. Operate under existing light levels within and outside the premises. 9. Have the recording device located in a secure area or locked cabinet. 10. Have a monitor to review images and recorded picture quality. 11. Be regularly maintained to ensure continuous quality of image capture retention. 12. Have signage displayed in the customer area to advise that CCTV is in operation. 13. Digital images must be kept for 31 days. 14. Police will have access to images at any reasonable time. 15. The equipment must have a suitable export method, e.g. CD/DVD writer so that the police can make an evidential copy of the data they require. This data should be in the native file format, to ensure that no image quality is lost when making the copy, if this format is non-standard (i.e. manufacturer proprietary) then the manufacturer should supply the replay software to ensure that the video on the CD can be replayed by the police on a standard computer. Copies must be made available to Police on request.

c) Public safety

Appropriate fire safety procedures are in place including fire extinguishers, internally illuminated fire exit signs, numerous smoke detectors and emergency lighting (see enclosed plan for details of locations). All appliances are inspected annually. All emergency exits shall be kept free from obstruction at all times.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

All customers will be asked to leave quietly. Clear and legible notices will be prominently displayed to remind customers to leave quietly and have regard to our neighbours.

e) The protection of children from harm

The licensee and staff will ask persons who appear to be under the age of 25 for photographic ID such as proof of age cards, the Connexions Card and Citizen Card, photographic driving licence or passport, an official identity card issued by HM Forces or by an EU country, bearing the photograph and date of birth of bearer. All staff will be trained for UNDERAGE SALES PREVENTION regularly. A register of refused sales shall be kept and maintained on the premises.





I am writing to register my objection to the application for a premises licence by Atlas Licensing Limited on behalf of Suleyman Hayirli.

The basis for this opposition is that granting a licence for these premises will promote disorder and antisocial behaviour as experienced each weekend and some evenings.

The application proposes that alcohol will be sold for consumption off the premises between 8:00am and 23.00pm, seven days a week. Granting a licence would provide a further source of alcohol within an area already so heavily populated with licensed premises that crime, disorder and public nuisance have already reached problem levels for the local residents. Increasing numbers of premises selling alcohol together with lack of policing on the street will only add to the problem in this area with majority of residential properties.

Residents in this area already suffer noise nuisance and antisocial behaviour at all hours of the day and night, within a Town Centre with many pubs, restaurants, and shops.

In view of the above, I would urge the Licensing Authority to refuse the application under the grounds:

I am writing to register my objection to the application for a premises licence by Atlas Licensing Limited on behalf of Suleyman Hayirli.

The basis for this opposition is that granting a licence for these premises will promote disorder and antisocial behaviour as experienced each weekend and some evenings also people buying and consuming alcohol usually cause disorder and pose danger to the public.

The application proposes that alcohol will be sold for consumption off the premises between 8:00am and 23.00pm, seven days a week. Granting a licence would provide a further source of alcohol within an area already so heavily populated with licensed premises that crime, disorder and public nuisance have already reached problem levels for the local residents. Increasing numbers of premises selling alcohol together with lack of policing on the street will only add to the problem in this area with majority of residential properties.

Residents in this area already suffer noise nuisance and antisocial behaviour at all hours of the day and night, within a Town Centre with many pubs, restaurants, and shops.

In view of the above, I would ask the Licensing Authority to refuse the application under the grounds:

To prevent crime and disorder: Sometimes you have already drunk people going to buy more alcohol, drunk people causing arguments, disorder and fighting.

The prevention of public nuisance: Noise, drunken disorderly people.
