 - Essex Waste Partnership Inter-Authority Member Working Group (Deputy);
 - Harlow-Stansted Gateway Transportation Board; and
 - North Essex Parking Partnership.
- 2. The appointment of members to these external organisations is a matter reserved to the Leader of the Council. The Leader has determined that Councillor S. Kane (as Safer, Greener and Transport Portfolio Holder) be appointed as the Council's representative on each organisation for the remainder of the 2017/18 municipal year.
- 3. Arising from the death of former Councillor Waller, it was also necessary to appoint new representatives to the following external organisations on which Councillor Waller previously represented the Council:
 - Epping Forest Community Transport Board of Trustees;
 - Essex Police and Crime Panel; and
 - Stansted Airport Consultative Committee (Deputy).
- 4. The appointment of members to these external organisations is a matter reserved to the Council. At its meeting on 26 September 2017, the Council will appoint appropriate member representatives to each organisation for the remainder of the 2017/18 municipal year.
