1.1 Former Councillor N. Green OBE

The Council is invited to stand for a minute's silence in tribute to the memory of former District Councillor Norma Green OBE, who passed away recently.

Norma Green served as a Conservative district councillor representing the High Beach ward of the district from 1995 to 2002. During her term of office, former Councillor Green served on various committees, sub-committees and working groups, including:

Former Councillor Green also sat as the Council's representative on the Epping Forest Locality Youth Service Local Strategy Group and Management Committee and the local Crime and Disorder Strategy Panel. Norma Green was highly active in the local community. Until 2018 she chaired the YES Partnership supporting young people in their interaction with employers when leaving school looking for work, she established WAY2000 (Waltham Abbey Youth 2000) to help local children have somewhere to relax in the evening, and created WAYPIC (Waltham Abbey Young Persons Information Centre) as a follow-up of further support for youngsters in Waltham Abbey. Former Councillor Green also chaired the Waltham Abbey Town Partnership for several years and was instrumental in many of its initiatives.

Norma Green was awarded an OBE for political services was also awarded Citizen of the Year by the Council in 2011.

This Council resolves:

- to require all public firework displays within the local authority boundaries to be advertised in advance of the event, allowing residents to take precautions for their animals and vulnerable people;
- to actively promote a public awareness campaign about the impact of fireworks on animal welfare and vulnerable people – including the precautions that can be taken to mitigate risks;
- to write to the UK Government urging them to introduce legislation to limit the maximum noise level of fireworks to 90dB for those sold to the public for private displays; and
- to encourage local suppliers of fireworks to stock ‘quieter’ fireworks for public display.
