**1. We R Safe Ripples – Sonny Bazzoni**

Sonny gave a presentation about the latest Youth Council project, the 6<sup>th</sup> film in the We R Safe series. We 'R' Safe consists of 5 Community Safety films that were devised by the 2018-2020 Youth Council to promote safety amongst young people in the district. The 5 films star the Youth Councillors, each comprises of a different element of safety, the 5 'R's' are Realise, Run, Report, Resist and Resilience. Ripples will be the 6<sup>th</sup> film to address the Ripple Effect that occurs after a serious incident or crime. The Ripples can affect the victim, the family, the friends and support services. The film aims to sign post to support services such as Victim Support and the Street Doctors. Script writing will commence 2 June 2021, Filming will start on 3 June and the film will be launched in schools September 2021.
