2. Introductions and Welcome by Chairman, Sammy and Vice Chair, Lauren

Sammy welcomed all to the meeting.

3. Feedback from British Youth Council Members meeting

Martin, Sonny and Wendy attended part of the meeting, due to having another meeting to attend. Martin fed back to the Youth Council. He said it was interesting to hear what the BYC are doing. People spoke about what they were doing in their Youth Councils and EFYC explained about their current projects (MiLife C19 and We R Safe).

4. Feedback from Essex Youth Service Young Commissioners training – Daniel, Martin and Sonny

Daniel and Martin explained that they commission youth groups in the district.
