- Complaints against Parish Councillors At the last meeting of the Liaison Committee it was suggested in relation to complaints made by town/parish councillors about other members that joint working between the Standards Committee and the Epping Forest Association of Local Councils might lead to resolution of these problems as an alternative to the formal complaints procedure. This matter was raised at the meeting of the Epping Forest Association of Local Councils and it was generally felt that it was unnecessary to add another tier to the complaints procedure.
