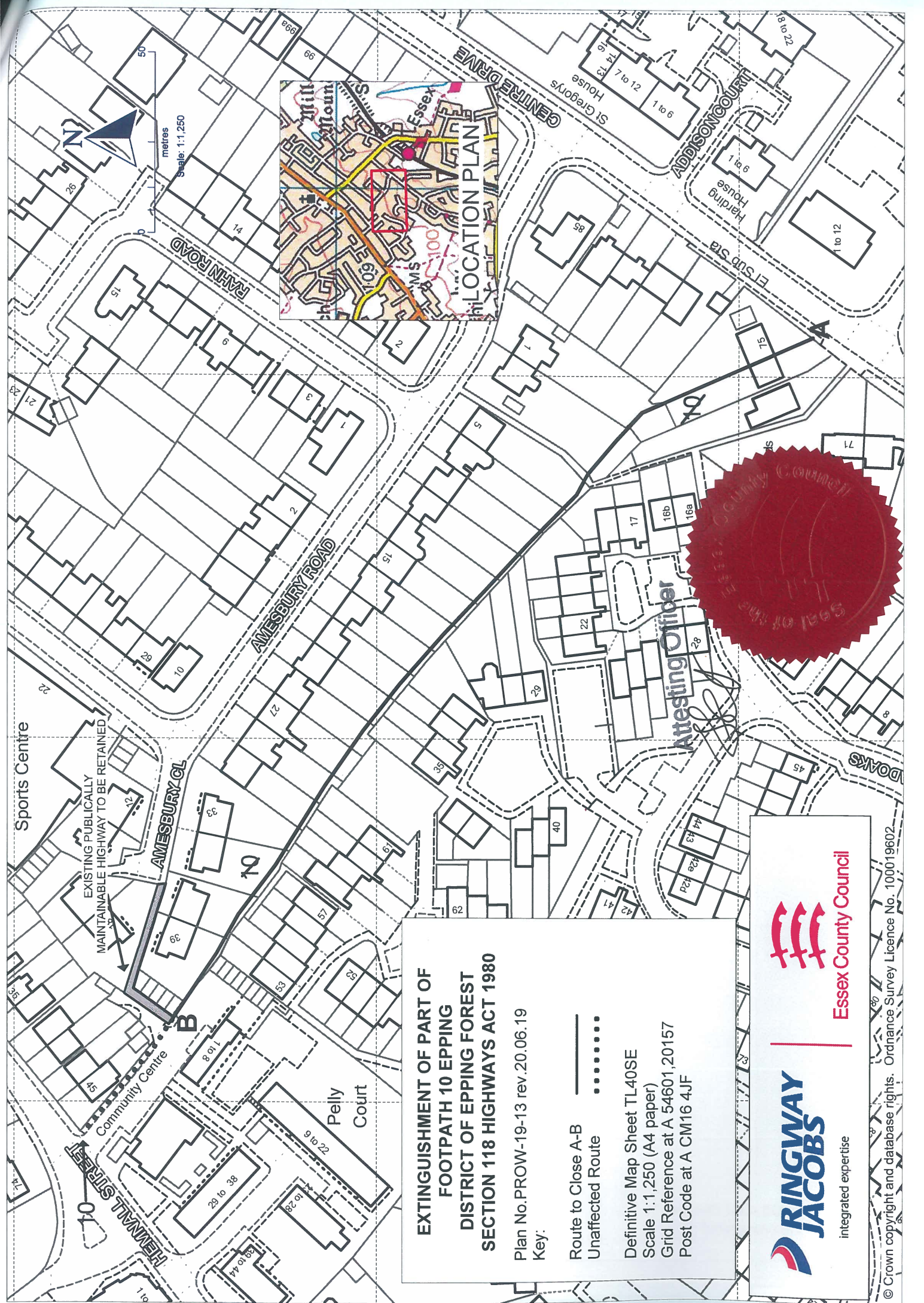

This Order is made by Essex County Council (“the authority”) under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that the footpath described in paragraph 1 below is not needed for public use.

Epping Forest District Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated south of Amesbury Road known as Footpath 10 in the parish of Epping in the District of Epping Forest and shown by a continuous bold line on the order map numbered PROW-19-13 rev.24.06.19 attached to this order and described in the Schedule to this order shall be extinguished after 14 days from the date of confirmation of this order

A part length of Footpath 10 Epping of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 54601,20157 where it meets the public highway known as Centre Drive running in a north north westerly then north westerly direction across numerous property boundaries and gardens for a total distance of approximately 263 metres to point **B** at grid reference 54582, 20175 where it continues unaffected.
