The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Chigwell) (Restricted Road & 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 201*

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

1. The length of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall become restricted road for the purpose of Section 81 of the Act.
2. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of roads, Chigwell in the District of Epping Forest as specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.
4. 'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Chigwell) (Restricted Road and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2007' hereby revoked. All restrictions contained within the aforementioned orders will remain in force by virtue of this order.
5. This Order shall come into operation on ***** and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Chigwell) (Restricted Road & 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 201*.

Schedule 1 – Restricted Road

Road	Description
A113 High Road, Chigwell	From the point of the original termination point of the restricted road, a point adjacent to the boundary of Broadoaks, High Road, generally in a north-easterly direction to a point approximately 70 metres northeast of its junction with Green Lane.
Vicarage Lane, Chigwell	From its junction with B173 Lambourne Road/Manor Road, north west for approximately 93 metres.

Schedule 2 – 40MPH

Road	Description
A113 High Road/ Abridge Road, Chigwell	From a point approximately 70 metres northeast of its junction with Green Lane to a point approximately 250 metres north east of its junction with Pudding Lane. A total distance of approximately 1620 metres.
A1168 Chigwell Road, Chigwell	From its junction with the A113 Abridge Road (Rolls Park Corner) in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 745 metres.
Vicarage Lane, Chigwell	From a point approximately 125 metres southeast of its junction with Daleside Gardens (at Rose Bridge) south eastwards to a point approximately 93 metres north west of its junction with the B173 Lambourne Road/Manor Road.

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Chigwell) (Restricted Road & 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 201*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 81, 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the order: To extend the existing 40MPH speed limit on the following length of A113 Abridge Road, Chigwell in the District of Epping Forest, from a point approximately 25 metres north east of the north eastern kerb line of Pudding Lane, north east for approximately 225 metres (the road is currently national speed limit):

'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Chigwell) (Restricted Road and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2007' is hereby revoked. All restrictions contained within the aforementioned order will remain in force by virtue of this order.

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Chigwell) (Restricted Road & 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 201*

Statement of Reasons

Following the Road Safety Audit prompted by five personal injury collisions at this location since 2014 including one resulting a fatality, we are proposing to extend the current 40mph limit further north east to encompass the junctions that form the entrances to the commercial site including the country club, golf course and health club.

It is expected that reducing the speeds of vehicles passing this intersection will increase the passing road user's awareness of this currently relatively hidden junction, and will enable more reasonable stopping distances to be maintained by those travelling on this section of the A113 Abridge Road.

Further to this a 40mph limit here will seek to ensure that vehicles leaving the commercial site will be better able to join the A113 Abridge Road at more reasonable speeds preventing the potential for erratic acceleration during peak traffic flow.

This is part of the larger scheme to provide safer exiting of vehicles from the commercial site on to the A113 Abridge Road. It is considered that a 40mph limit would not be an unnatural change to users of this road as it fits with existing limits.

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2), 82 (2), 83(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall become restricted roads for the purpose of Section 81 of the Act.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
3. Epping Forest District Council (High Road and Vicarage Lane, Chigwell) (30 and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2003 is hereby revoked.
4. This Order may be cited as The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Chigwell) (Restricted Road and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 and shall come into operation on 18 June 2007.

SCHEDULE 1

Restricted Roads

Lengths of road at Chigwell in the District of Epping Forest

A113 High Road	From the point of the original termination point of the restricted road, a point adjacent to the boundary of Broadoaks, High Road, generally in a north-easterly direction to a point approximately 70 metres northeast of its junction with Green Lane.
Vicarage Lane	From its junction with Lambourne Road/Manor Road to a point 93 metres north of that junction.

SCHEDULE 2

40mph Speed Limit

Lengths of road at Chigwell in the District of Epping Forest

A113 High Road	From a point approximately 70 metres northeast of its junction with Green Lane generally in a north easterly direction to a point approximately 35 metres north east of the junction with the A1168 at Rolls Park Corner.
A113 Abridge Road	From a point 35 metres northeast of its junction with the A1168 Chigwell Lane (Rolls Park Corner) in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 670 metres.
A1168 Chigwell Road	From its junction with the A113 Abridge Road (Rolls Park Corner) in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 745 metres.
Vicarage Lane	From a point approximately 125 metres southeast of its junction with Daleside Gardens (at Rose Bridge) south eastwards to a point 93 metres north of its junction with the B173 Lambourne Road.
