As you may be aware Swallow Coaches went into receivership on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> April. The County Council has been looking at ways to find a replacement service during these difficult times.

We are pleased to inform you that Epping Forest Community Transport have kindly agreed to operate a service for us commencing Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> April. The service will also run Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> April and Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> April. There will be no service Good Friday or Easter Monday. Then the service will resume again on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> April.

The service will operate to the current Saturday service 13 timetable, with the exception of the 18.15 journey from Waltham Cross to St Margarets Hospital.
