Nevertheless, the trustees have not been inactive during this time and it is with great pleasure that I can announce their successful bid of £104,000 from the Government's Cultural Recovery Fund, to assist them with heritage projects. The funds need to be spent by March 2021 and the trustees are very busy preparing and submitting different plans/projects, as these plans/projects have to be approved first before any of the money is released. There will be a national press release soon.
